



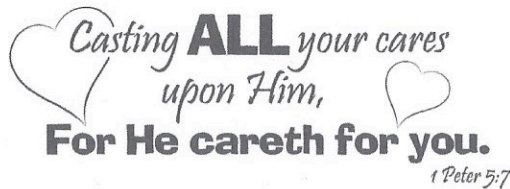

Earthly distractions create temporal priorities; quiet time with God creates spiritual priorities.

Earthly distractions militate against doctrines taught in God's Word; quiet time with God reinforces what the Bible teaches.

Earthly distractions lead to making excuses about our behavior; quiet time with God leads us to the blessings of correct behavior.

Earthly distractions direct us down the unscriptural paths; quiet time with God directs down the scriptural paths for our lives.

Earthly distractions do not exalt God; quietness with God exalts Him.
